TO OUR DEAR LISTENERS—we extend sincere gratitude for inviting us into your autumn playlists, and we are thrilled to share this album with all of similar hearts.

The two of us have been dear friends for many years—both coming from careers in the commercial music industry, which is how our paths fatefully intertwined. Hence, a collaboration of deep mutual respect and inspiration was born, walking the path together to create this new chapter as musical storytellers.

We learned quickly of our shared love for things that go bump in the night. Uniquely, retro Halloween television specials, vintage Halloween vinyl albums, and orange cassette tapes filled with Halloween stories and poetry. The witch's brew of these ingredients shaped what would become *A Halloween Carol*. All of the music on this album is entirely original: Sarah is our leading lady, and Rick produced, arranged, and orchestrated our journey. We wrote every lyric, melody, script, and story—performing all vocals and spoken voices.

Our titular villain began as a memory Sarah shared about her childhood imaginary skeleton friend-turned-foe—whom young Sarah had named *Ro-Why-Where*. We instantly realized her character was the key to tying our story together, prompting us to create the town where this entity and his ancient curse reside: *Grimwood*.

You may notice our stylistic love letters that honor our favorite seasonal soundtracks and their creators. Our profound thanks to these haunting inspirations: Vera Lynn; *The Twilight Zone* \mathfrak{M} ; the vintage cassette tapes for *It's Halloween* by Jack Prelutsky and *In a Dark Dark Room and Other Scary Stories* by Alvin Schwartz; *Garfield's*

Halloween Adventure, Daffy Duck's Quackbusters, E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial, Crimson Peak, The Others, What Lies Beneath; and the brilliant scores of Jerry Goldsmith, Irwin Kostal, George Bruns, and Bernard Herrmann.

At the album's heart is the title song, *A Halloween Carol*—presented in the spirit of a nineteen-fifties holiday recording—the era that gave us the sound of many Christmas classics. While composing this song, we reminisced about Halloween being the one night all felt comfortable dressing how they dreamed of being seen and seeing themselves. As devoted LGBTQIA+ advocates, this realization of "dressing how you feel inside" gave immediate new purpose to the song and the entire project.

To all beguiled by jack-o-lantern-lit porches decorated in autumn leaves—to those who have counted their candy with loved ones at the hearth of a fire's glow—and to all who may be new to this holiday: Our wish is to capture a nostalgic, heartfelt celebration of imagination and self-expression for those of any age. All are welcome through the gates of Grimwood. Come as you are—dressed up how you feel inside.
